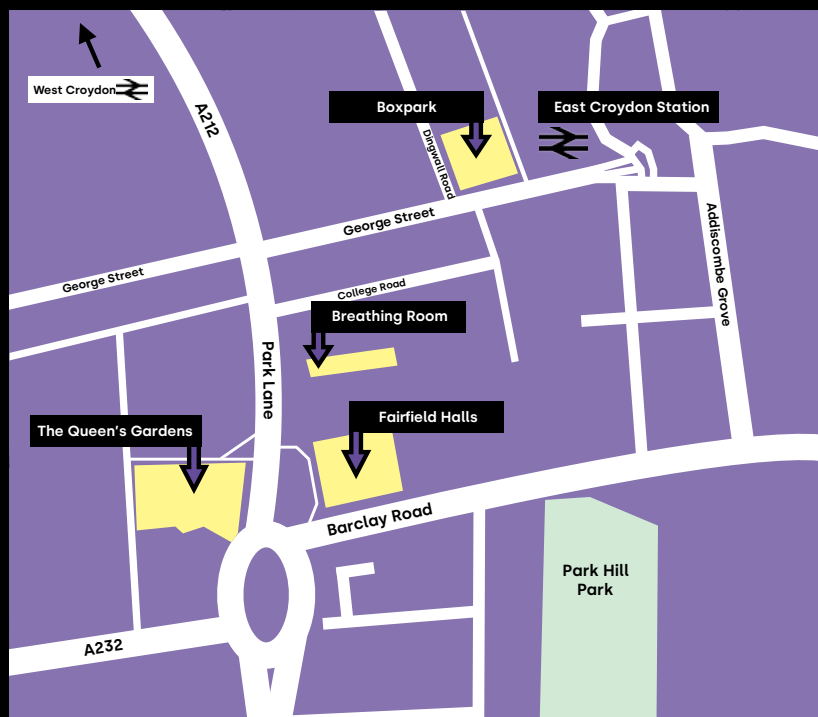
Access
