


- Who do you think the people in the painting might be? Do they know each other?

Get Involved




How to fold



Cut out the square and fold in half both ways. Then unfold colour-side down.




Fold all four corners in towards the middle.




Turn over and fold all four corners into the middle again.



Fold in half.



Pinch at corners and push inwards.
